The Clinics provide low-income clients the opportunity to speak with a volunteer attorney about legal questions and receive advice about how to resolve them. All information provided at the Legal Services Clinics will be treated confidentially.

We provide brief legal services in most civil (non-criminal) areas of law, services for DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals), and brief legal advice/services for immigration.
